## AN ACT

#### RELATING TO PROPERTY - MORTGAGE FORECLOSURE AND SALE

It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

- SECTION 1. Chapter 34-27 of the General Laws entitled "Mortgage Foreclosure and
  Sale" is hereby amended by adding thereto the following section:
- 3 <u>34-27-6. Payment of outstanding taxes. -- (a) In connection with any sale by public</u>
- 4 <u>auction made under and according to the provisions of any mortgage of real estate or any power</u>
- 5 of sale contained therein or annexed thereto, the successful bidder for the estate or property so put
- 6 up for sale shall, within thirty (30) days of the date of the sale, record a foreclosure deed in the
- 7 <u>municipality</u> where the real estate is located in order to evidence the conveyance of title of the
- 8 real estate to the successful bidder.
- 9 (b) Notwithstanding any general law or local ordinance to the contrary, upon the 10 recording of a foreclosure deed, the grantee of the real estate as stated in the foreclosure deed
- 11 shall pay to the municipality all outstanding taxes (including interest and penalties) due and
- 12 <u>owing on the real estate.</u>
- 13 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage.

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1 This act would require foreclosure deeds to be recorded within thirty (30) days of the
